Proposed Ordinance Feedback

- Concern - What service do I receive for these fees?
- Concern - Equitability of fees – fee structure, exemption for compliant water systems
- Concern - Inspections are not necessary – government intrusion
- Support - Real estate community, some Group B water systems, water system purveyors, and satellite management agencies



Group B Water System Services – Required

- Review of building permits for water adequacy – (RCW 19.27, KCC 14.04, BOH 1999-6 fee supported)
- Perform sanitary surveys and issue water status reports (fee supported, required in our BOH 1999-6 ordinance)
- Water service area coordination and data sharing (required by Kitsap County’s Coordinated Water System Plan (CWSP))
- Water system expansion and maintaining water supply records (CWSP)
- Maintain and update water system records (public information)
- Responding to public inquiries (public information)
- Water system compliance and enforcement (required in BOH 1999-6)



Group B Water System Services – Not Required

- Providing technical assistance to water systems
- Providing reminder postcards to collect required routine monitoring samples
